Our themes are also designed to; revise earlier material, work with the level of each group and develop the communication and learning ability of each child.

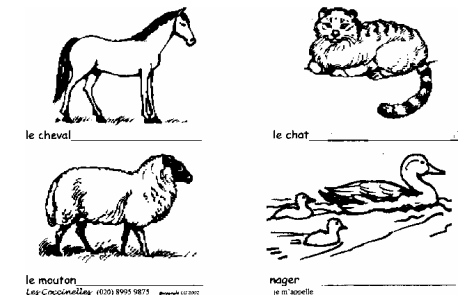
Our programme includes the government scheme of work for MFL in primary school.

Hand outs

Every term schools will get a themed **A4 poster** (see example).



Every three weeks KS1 children will each receive a **colouring page** to take home with main words related to their theme (see example).



KS2 children will receive a **fun exercise page** to encourage them in making sentences, reading and in writing.

Lessons

Lessons are happy and busy with plenty of activities. These include; stimulating language games, exercises, songs and stories all in French using educational toys and puppets to encourage participation. The lessons have a structured routine to them which allows the children to feel at ease and gives them confidence to interact in French.

Teachers

Our teachers are French native speaking, qualified and experienced.

They are passionate about teaching, caring, dedicated and dynamic. Our teachers are also very sensitive to the needs of the children.

Lingua Badge Awards

For an additional fee our club can set up the "Lingua Badge Awards". This is a European project to assess and acknowledge young learner's linguistic achievement in the early year stages of foreign languages learning. The test is taken in year 6 for the Bronze award, but we encourage the children to take it earlier if they are ready. Upon completion each child will get a certificate and a badge.

Our Saturday club will run from Saturday 21st April for 10 weeks with a break for half term, lessons are from 10 to 11am for children from 5 to 11 years old. The lessons are one hour long with Sylvie, our French teacher.

With a one-hour session the children will be able to really immerse themselves in the language. They will have various activities with a lot of games, role-play to learn to introduce themselves, learn French songs and much more!

The group will have a maximum of 15 children and the room is big so our teacher can really bring the language to life for the children.
